



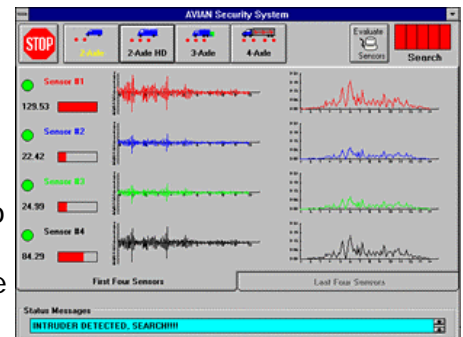

DEMO AT US BORDER CHECKPOINT

On **February 7th 2002**, the Heartbeat Detector was demonstrated at the **US Border Patrol's Laredo, TX check point**. In only a few hours, **the System detected twelve people** on trucks that had already been cleared for entry into the United States. Please see the attached CDROM with video taken from this scene. The US Border Patrol is seeking funding to purchase an immediate 300 AVIAN Systems for use at its 135 border check points around the country. **With this funding, the US Border Patrol will have the technology to keep illegal immigrants and terrorists from entering the US. Furthermore, the US Border Patrol will be able to prevent the death of illegal immigrants due to heat exhaustion.** By current law, some trucks caught with illegal immigrants can be confiscated and sold with proceeds returned to local and national law enforcement. **Consequently, the Heartbeat Detector will generate revenues sufficient to repay the expense of the technology.**

The **United Kingdom has completed its second order** of Heartbeat Detectors for use on its borders and is working on its third order under a four year implementation plan for this technology. David Blunkett, **the UK's Home Secretary, has accredited the Heartbeat Detector with reducing their illegal border infiltration at the Calais port by 98%!** In addition, **Spain** is working on its third order under a three year implementation plan, and **Italy** is issuing its first order in April of 2003 under a two year implementation plan. Orders are also expected from Germany, Poland, and Romania.

In **September 2001**, a few weeks after 9/11, a **truck with armed Iraqi nationals hidden inside** was discovered attempting to **infiltrate a US Air Force compound** in the United Kingdom. The entry guard just happened to hear someone move inside the vehicle which kept the Iraqis from entering the facility. The United States military has several thousand locations around the world that could use this technology.
